Trailers sitting longer than they should, slowing everything downstream



TECHNOLOGY GAPS

Not integrated across sites, not driving decisions in real time



COSTS OUT OF LINE

Long enough that the team stopped questioning them

» *Together, these three create the conditions that make transition unavoidable – and the fear that keeps it from happening.*

Why Operations Leaders Don't Move

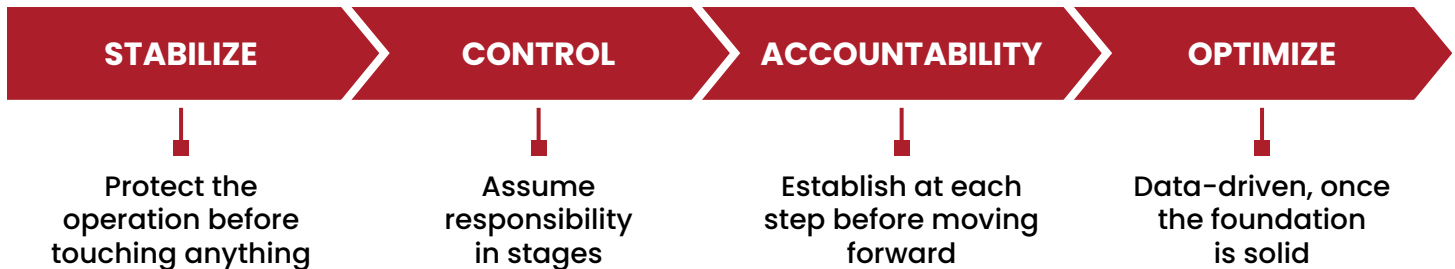
They fear disruption. Changing providers can feel riskier than staying with an operation that's still running—especially before peak season, when the stakes are highest.

THE FEAR	THE COST OF STAYING
Service disruption during transition	Yard stays congested
Operational instability	Visibility gap stays open
Unclear accountability	Numbers stay out of line
Wrong time — peak season coming	Same provider, same play

» *The risk of a controlled transition is almost always smaller than the cost of staying.*

What Controlled Transition Looks Like

Most logistics providers move straight into optimization once they take over an operation. MWL's Rapid Response Program is built on the opposite sequence:



» *Our performance data shows where to focus first, helping protect service levels and make the transition feel manageable, not reckless.*

In Practice

We operate eight yard management facilities across the Atlanta metro, as one provider with fast transitions that don't disrupt service.

Three Things We Bring To Every Transition

- 1 Immediate technology deployment paired with human accountability**
From day one, our technology provides real-time visibility into operations, costs, and performance. But tracking alone does not matter unless the data is also integrated across sites. We pair the technology with accountable experts who know how to interpret the data and act on it in real time.
- 2 A staged transition process**
We assume control in stages with accountability established at each step before moving to the next, which means the operation gets progressively stronger rather than temporarily disrupted.
- 3 Budget certainty**
We guarantee we'll be in budget every quarter, which isn't a standard commitment in this industry but has been a baseline for us from the beginning.
